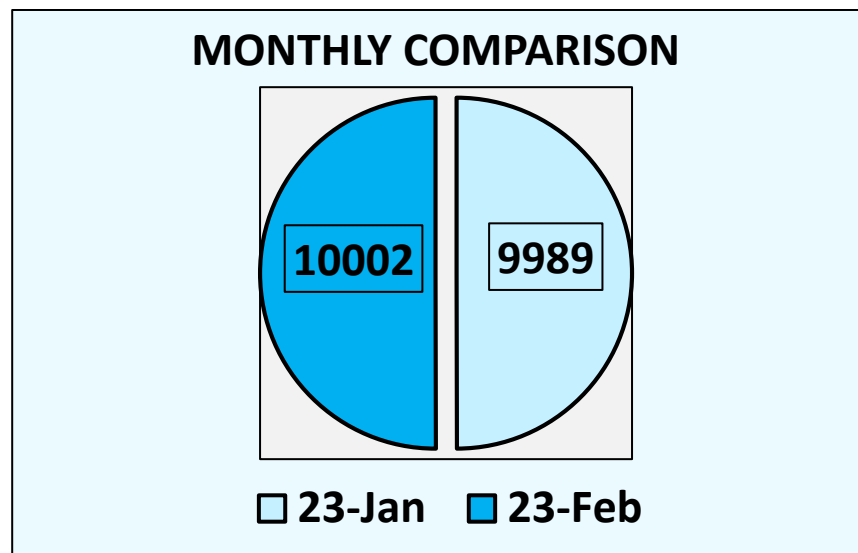
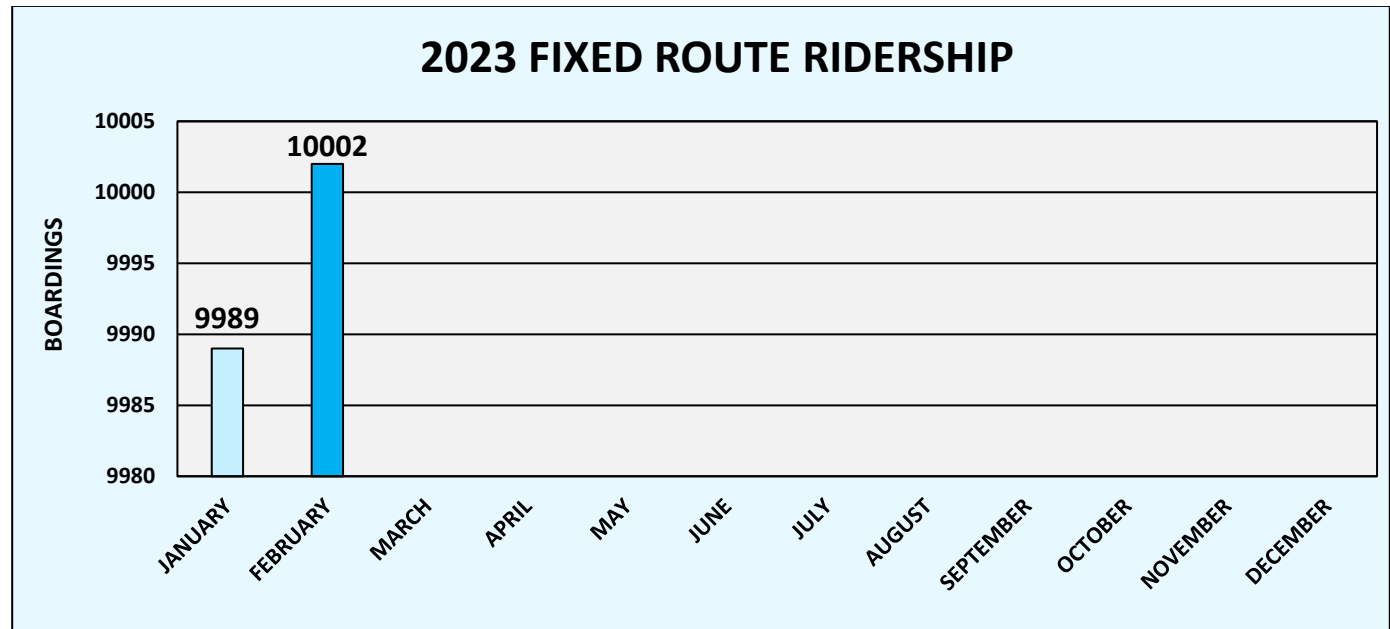

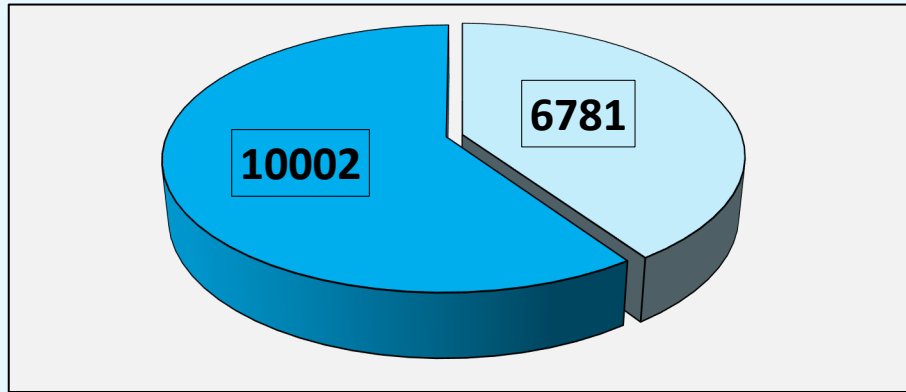

YEARLY COMPARISON



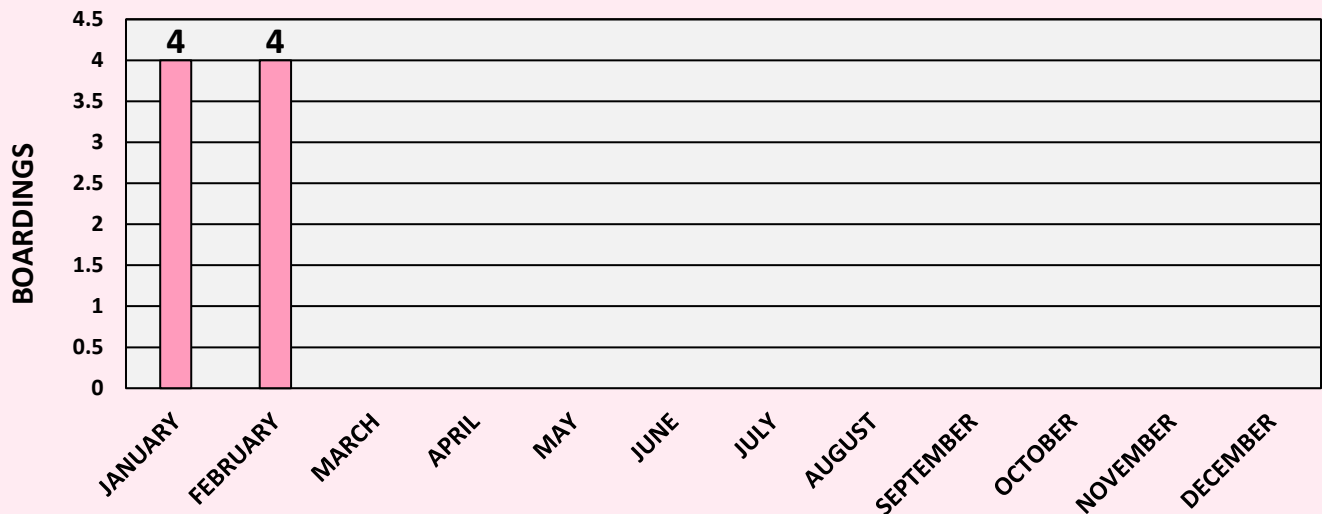

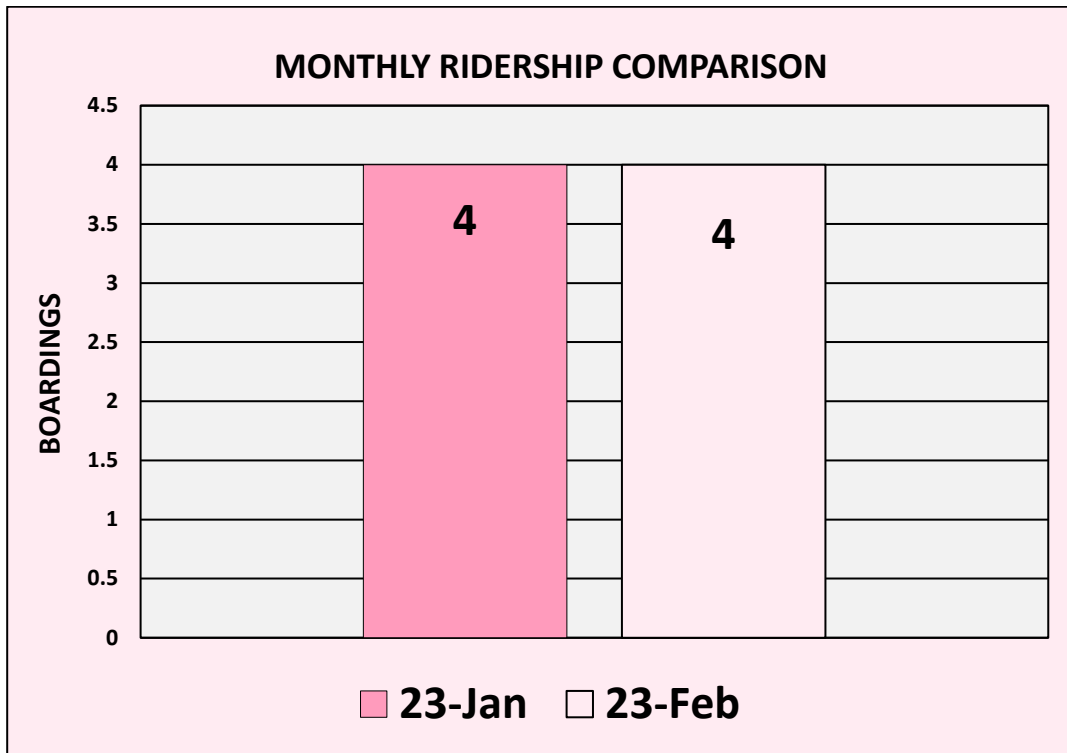
February 2022 to February 2023 +47%

SHARE MAP WITH BOARDING STATS

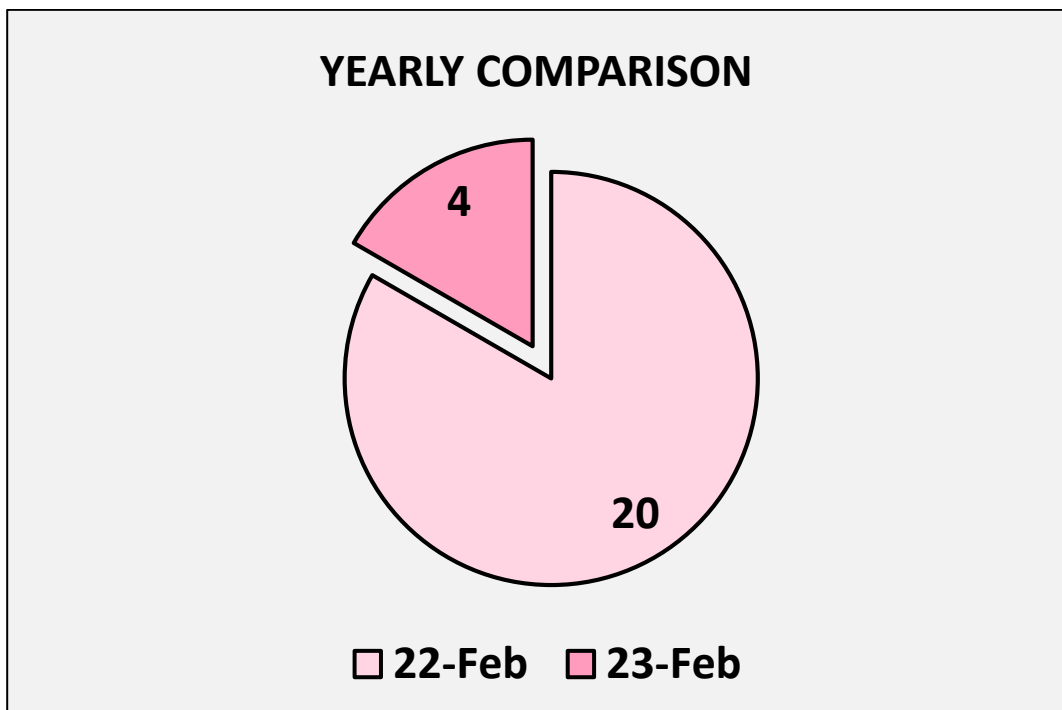

2023 PARATRANSIT RIDERSHIP



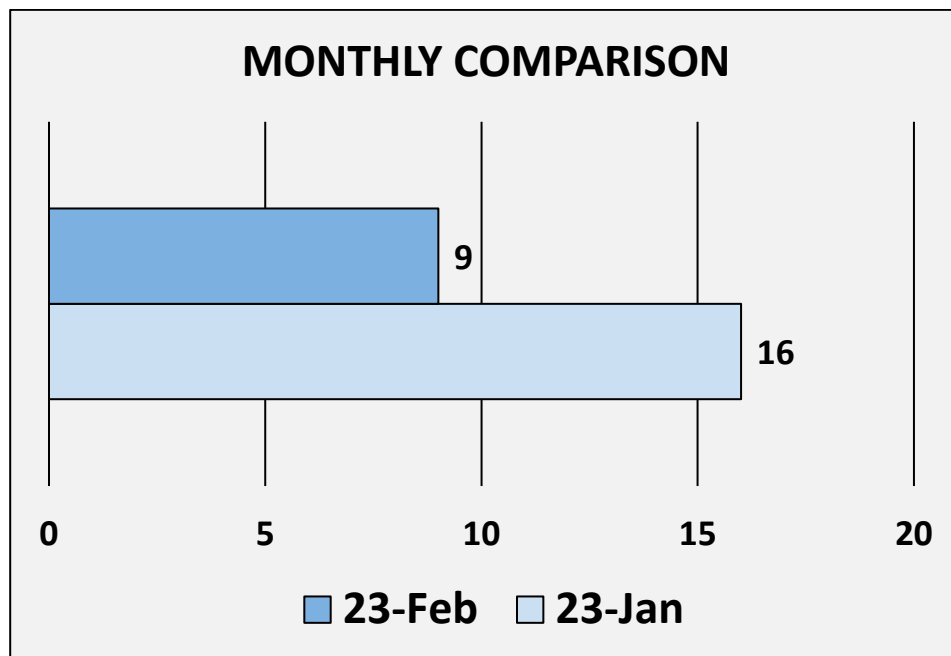
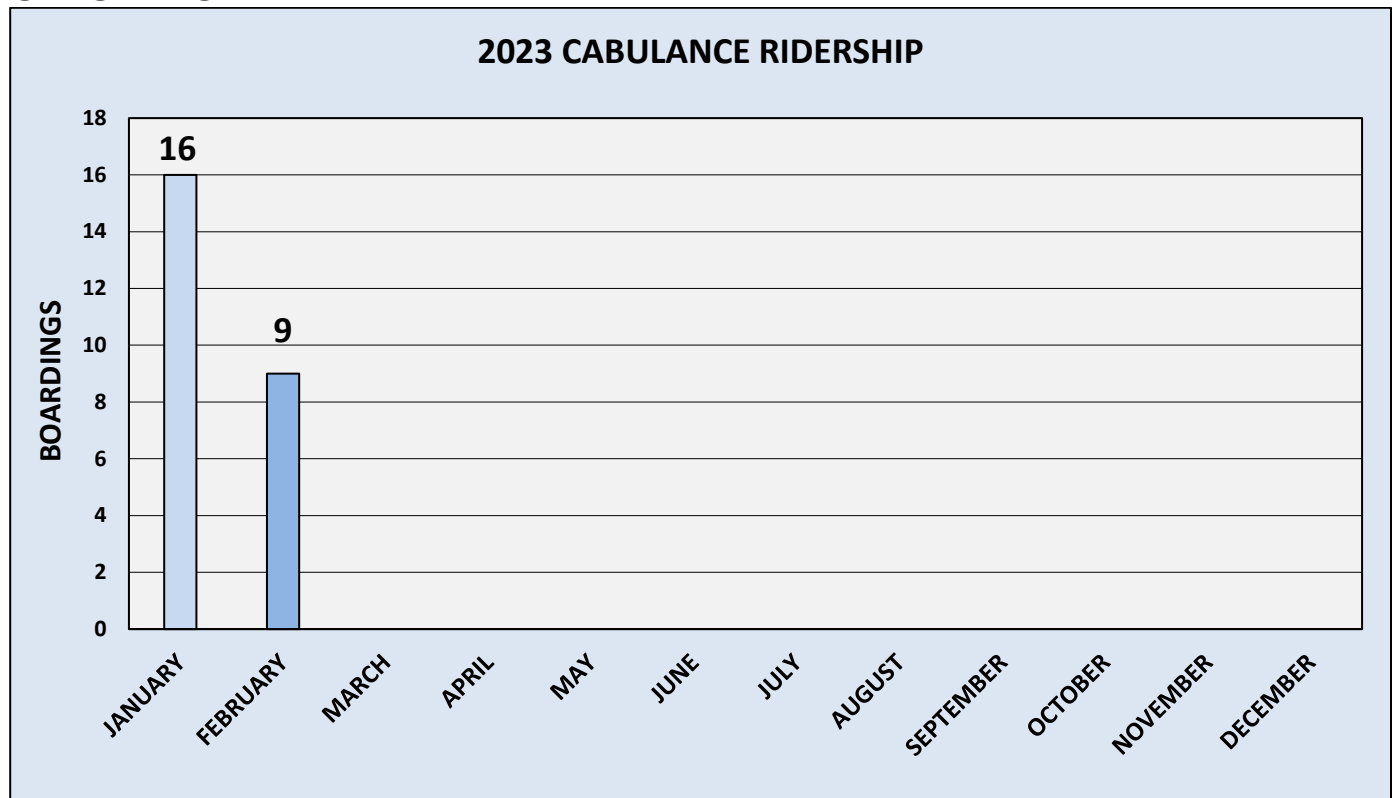

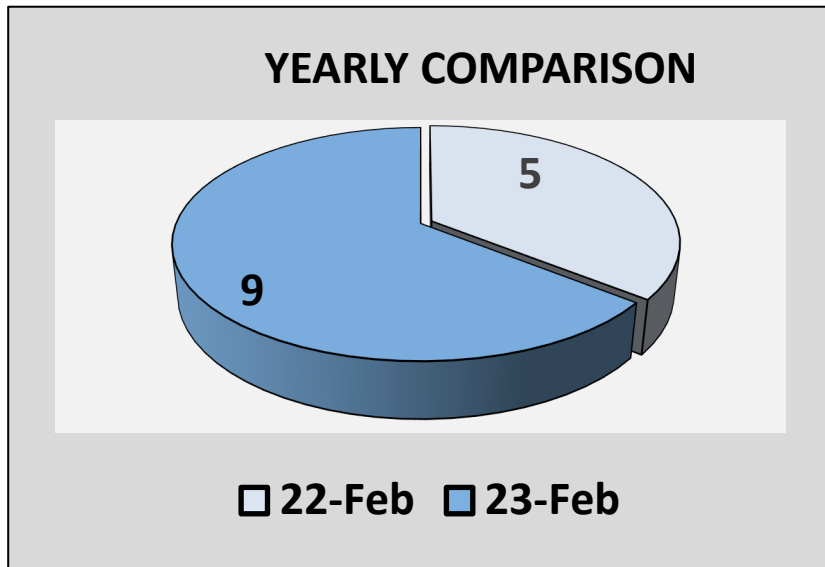

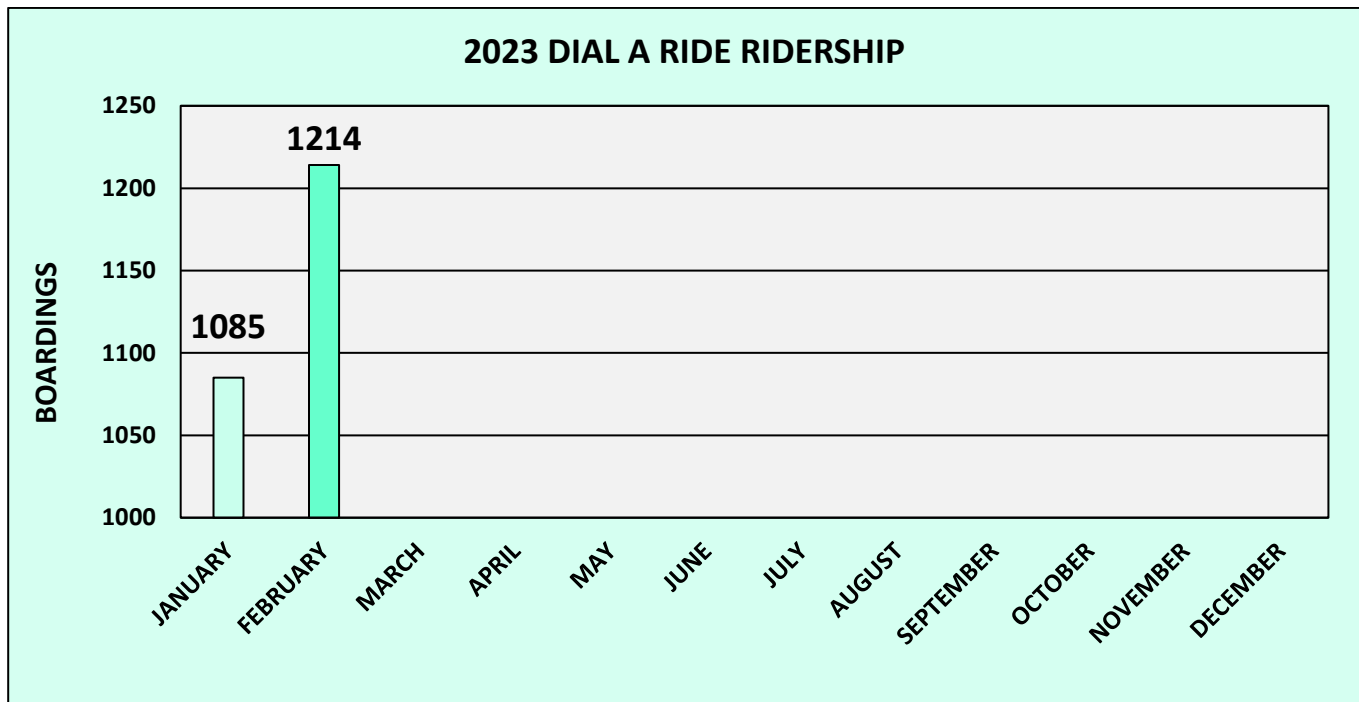

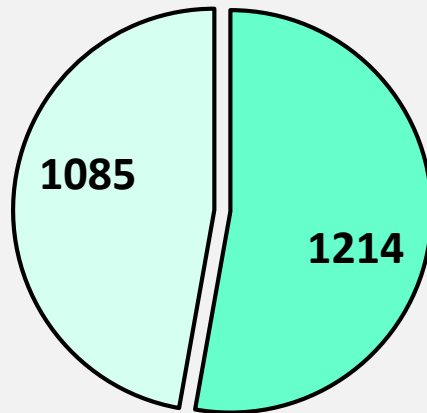

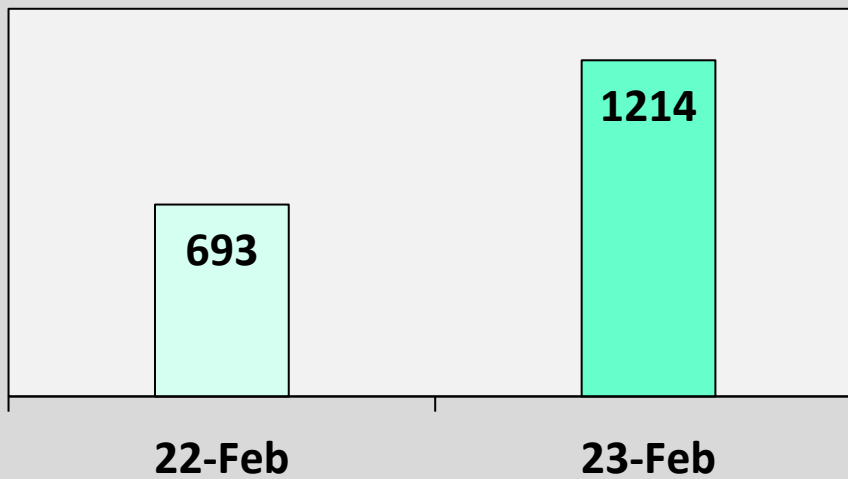
MONTHLY COMPARISON

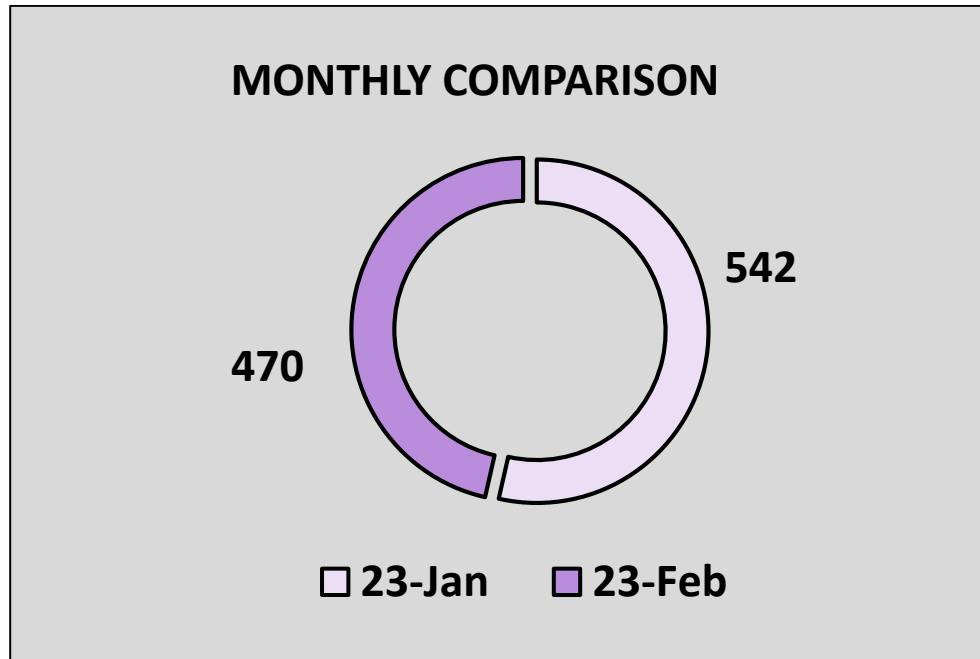
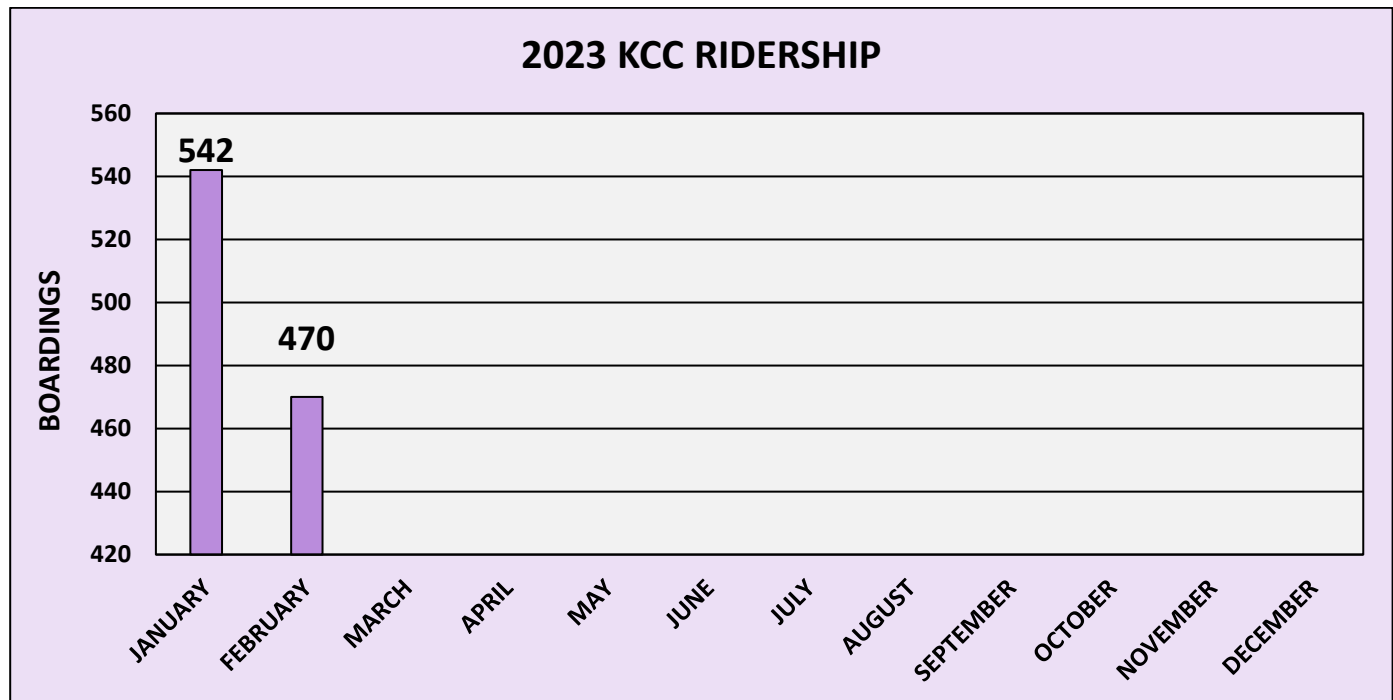
January 2023 to February 2023 12%

YTD COMPARISON



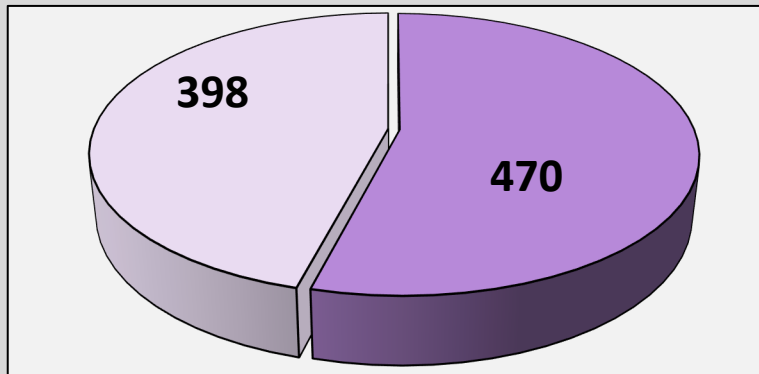

January 2023 to February 2023 -13%

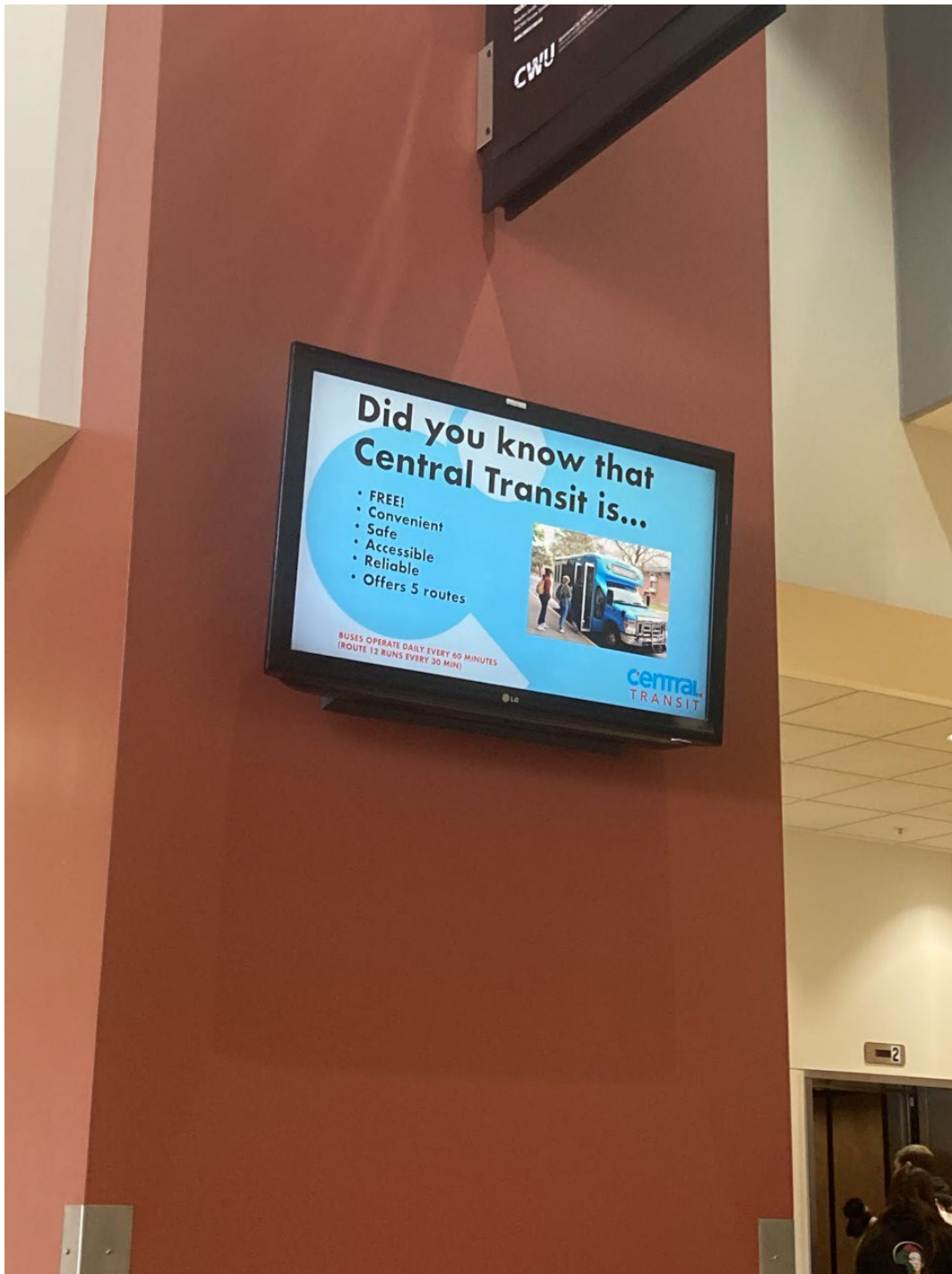

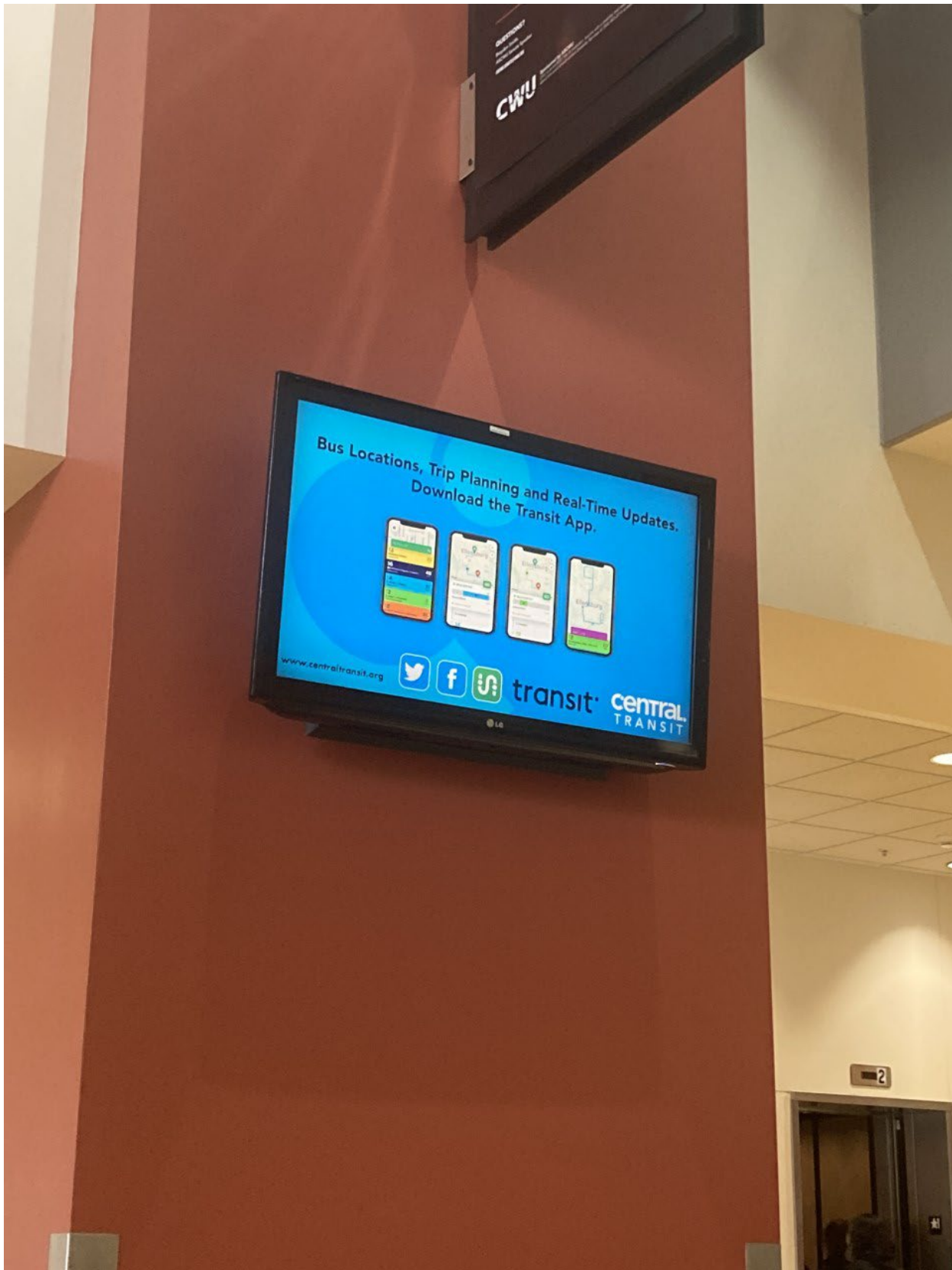

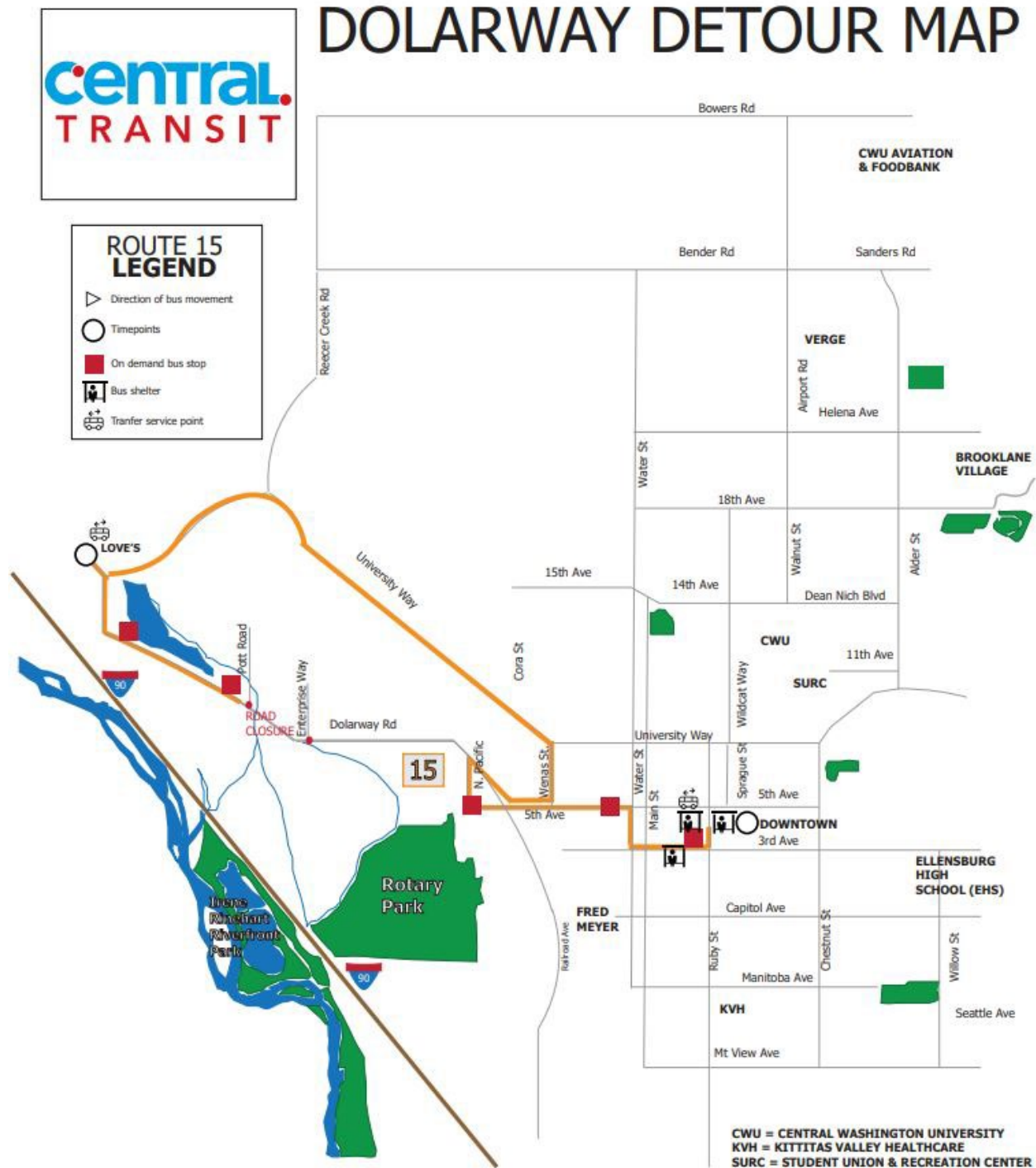


My piece consists of flora native to Ellensburg, including chokecherry, yarrow, globemallow, blanket flower, and Solomon's seal. The plants are held by green hands extending from one corner. Opposite of them are CWU crimson, orange, and tan hands reaching for the flora.

Symbolically, my piece encourages the viewer to reach out into nature. The many different-colored hands show the diversity of the University and greater Ellensburg population. No matter the background, the people that see the design will be reminded that Ellensburg has beautiful scenery we all contribute to.
