6. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

7. BUDGET/FINANCIAL REPORT

8. NEW BUSINESS

A. Mural Restoration: Joe Chanes presented restoration proposal of "the Hub" mural located on Kleinberg building at 307 N Pearl. One artist will be selected to restore the mural.

MOTION made by Scheffer to endorse application for proposed mural for 307 N Pearl, seconded, motion approved. Motion passed 6-0.

- B. New Mural: Renee Fyall presented mural proposal for 404 N Pine St, south side of Blue Rock Saloon. Proposal in coordination with EDA and to be completed before Rodeo weekend. Concern that parking lot may obstruct view. Commission not able to endorse at this time without further information. Commission request to see more finalized design.
- C. New Mural: Behrends-Cerniwey presented the 100yr Anniversary Rodeo Mural located at Craig's Hill Reservoir. Design was selected by mural selection committee consisting of Councilmember Nancy Lillquist, Yakama Nation/Artist Emily Washeens, Rodeo Board Members Dan Morgan and Scott Perna, Rodeo Manager Meegan Meeks, KVEC Director Kady Porterfield, Arts Commissioner Brian Kooser, LTAC Commission Member/Rodeo Hall of Fame Marie Smith, and City Public Works Assistant Director Mike Helgeson. 21 applications were submitted and narrowed down to three. The Rural Mural Plural proposed design was selected unanimously. Mural projected to be completed by the end of July 2023.
MOTION made by Snedeker to endorse mural rendering for water tower mural, seconded, motion approved. Motion passed 5-0.
- D. Bernard Hosey: Eyre reported the City of Walla Walla is offering free artwork by Bernard Hosey from Walla Walla but would incur costs with transport and installation. Public Art committee will investigate transit and installation options. Placement of possible artwork TBD. Parks and Recreation Commission will also need to approve if EAC is to go forward.

Artwalk Signs- Inventory of current signs have been completed. More signs will need to be ordered. Eyre looking into cost estimates.

Arts Treasure Award Presentation- Eyre and Dougherty propose a presentation to be held on June 1st 3:30pm at Blackhall in conjunction with Arts and Humanities Award. Snedeker will notify recipient for availability. Eyre will notify City PIO for promotion.

Ellensburg: A Certified Creative District

The City of Ellensburg hired an Arts & Economic Development Manager who will work with community partners and ArtsWa to complete the application to become a Certified Creative District. This state-run program helps turn cultural activities into economic growth.



Production/Performance Space Feasibility Study

With the help of our partner CenterFuse, we secured a \$25,000 grant and hired Place Dynamics to conduct a Production/Performance Space Feasibility Study that will be complete in September 2023. The scope of the study will include reviewing the needs of the community, an environmental scan, site analysis, positioning for success, and a full project report with recommendations for securing and creating the spaces our community needs.



Alliance Organizational Formation

Drafted and formalized organization bylaws, creating the path forward for the Ellensburg Arts & Cultural Alliance to achieve a recognized 501c3 nonprofit status.



Community Musician List

With the help of our partners at Ellensburg Community Radio (ECR), we have completed a community musician list to act as a resource to help promote and connect performers and venues. This will be an organic list that will continue to grow and be made available to the public.



Grant & Funding Resource List

Developing a list of potential grant and funding resources that will be available to all creative industry individuals and organizations to access and utilize.



Applying for Grants Workshop

Working with community partners to create a grant writing workshop that will help individuals and organizations have an increased success in securing grants.



Community Calendar App

In partnership with Central Washington University and CS481, we will be developing a community events app that will allow easy access to all events and opportunities within our region.
