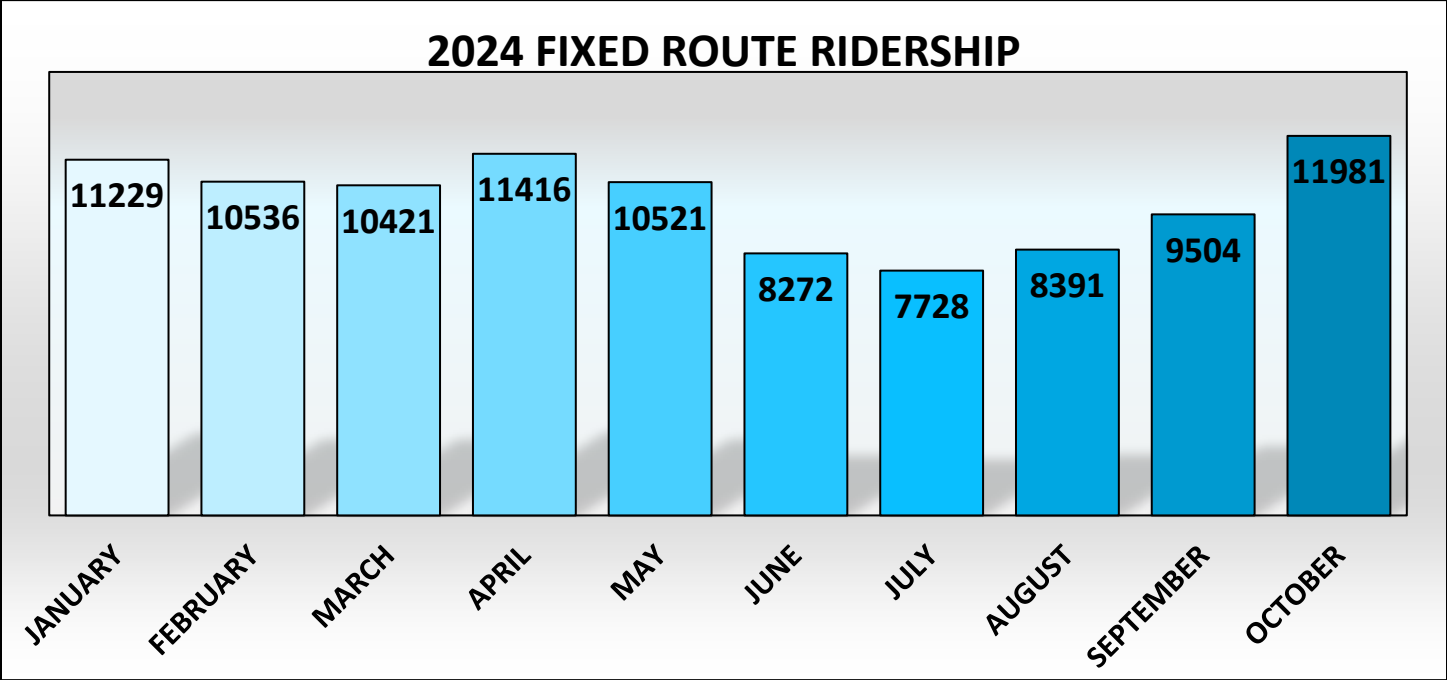

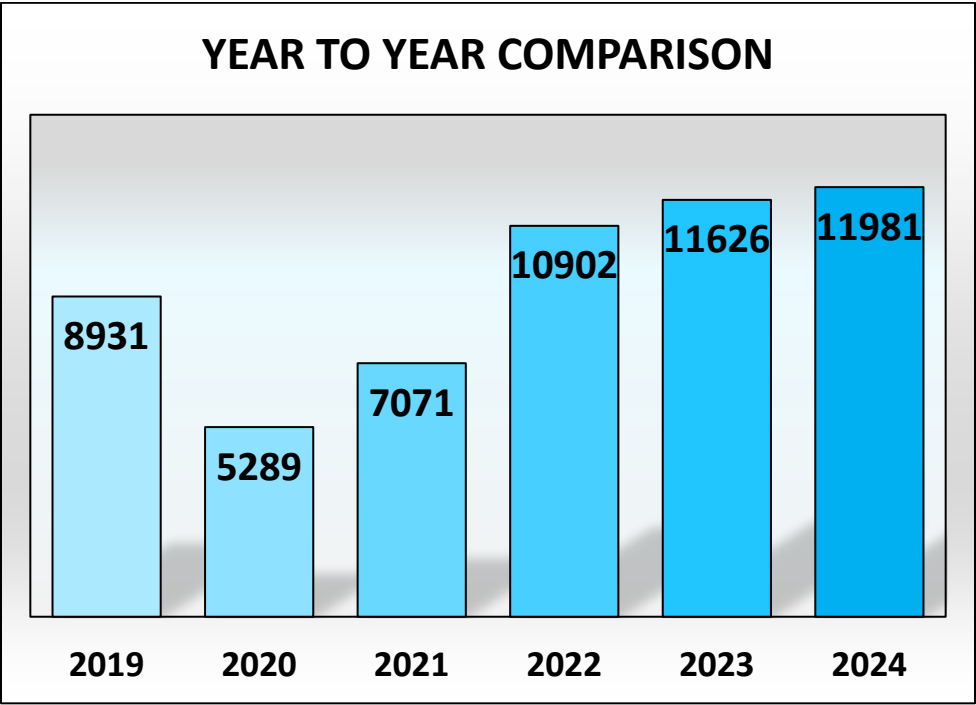

OCTOBER RIDERSHIP STATS

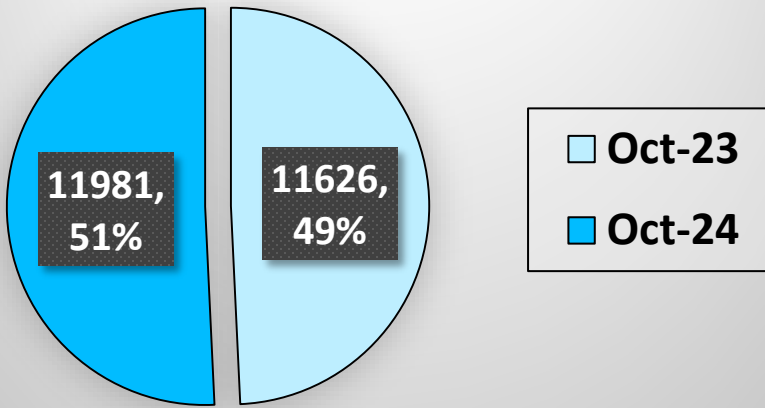
FIXED ROUTE



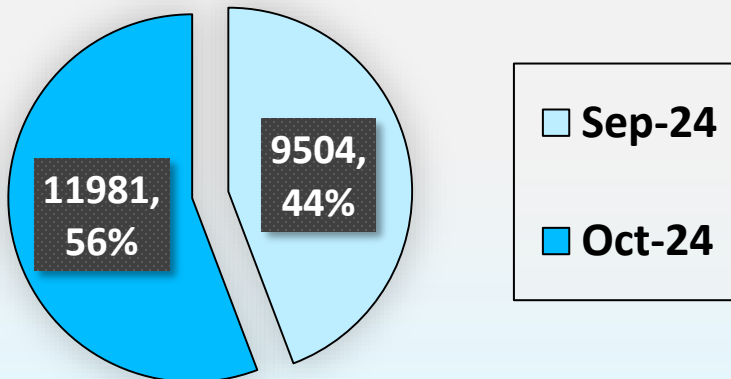
Highest Fixed Route Ridership in the history of Central Transit.



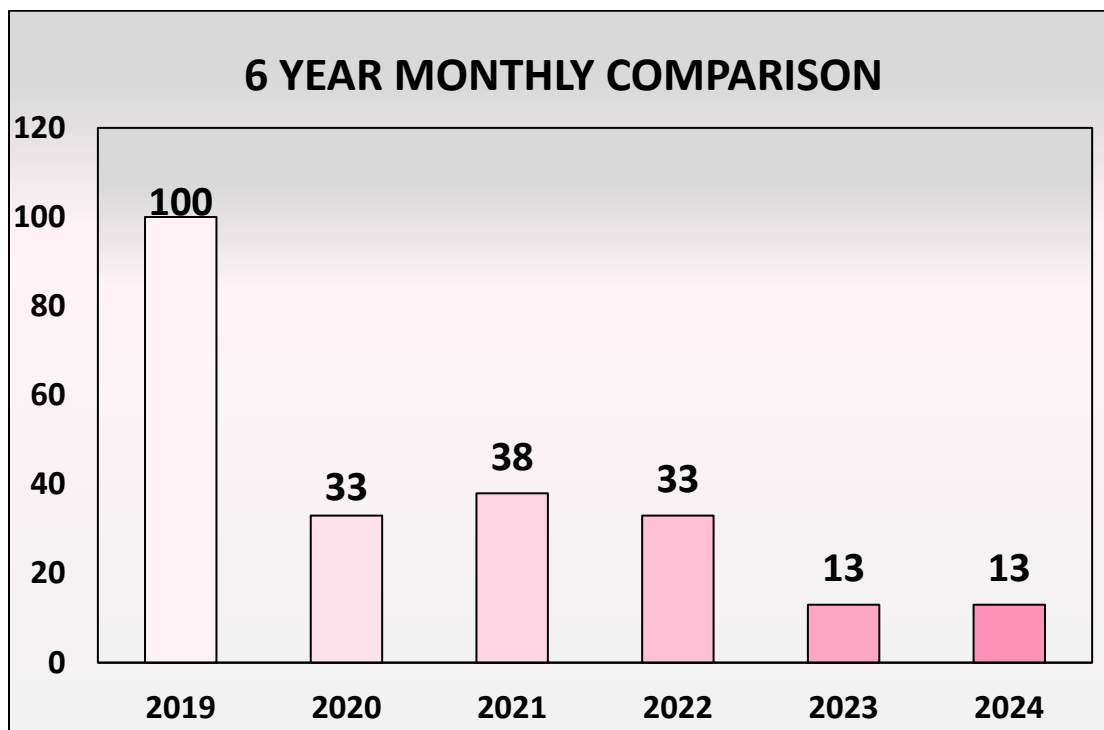
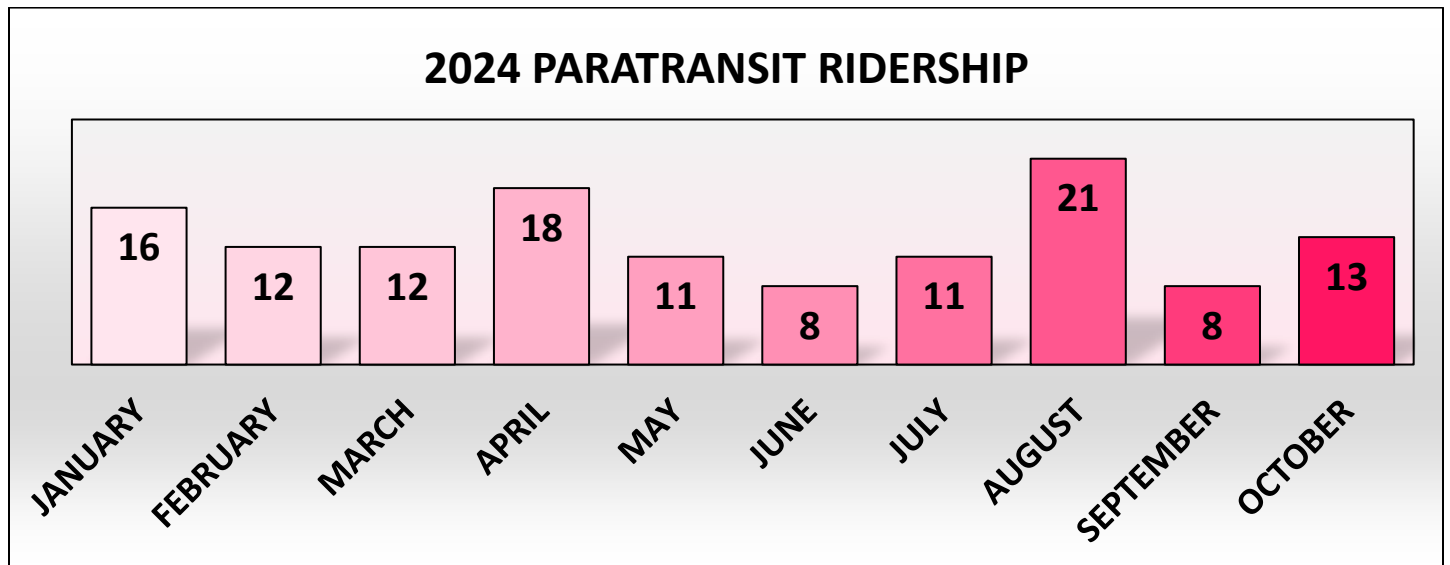
YEARLY COMPARISON



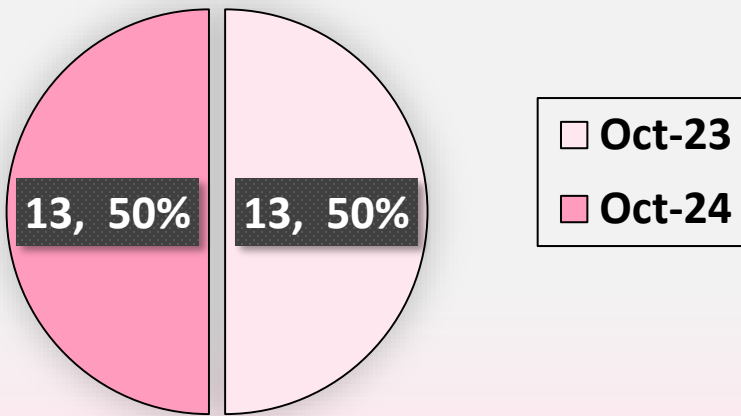
MONTHLY COMPARISON



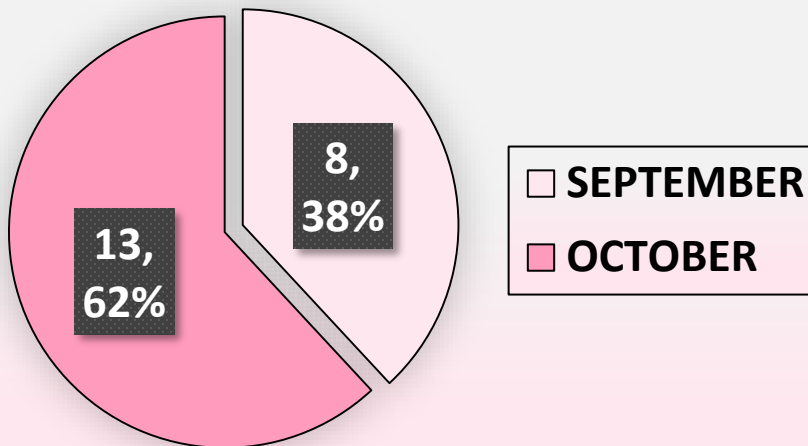
