Also present virtually via Zoom: one member of the public

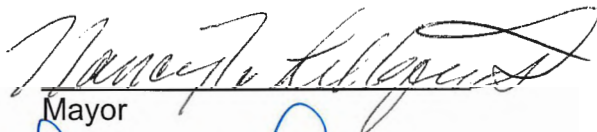
1. Streateries

The City Manager presented information to Council concerning the temporary structures. Nicole Klauss, City Public Information Officer, presented results of the survey. Brenda Devore, EDA Executive Director, spoke on behalf of the EDA in favor of continuation of streateries. Blake Collins, owner of The Pearl Bar & Grill; Mark Holloway, owner of D&M Coffee; and Sarah Beauchamp, owner of The Mule Bar, all spoke in favor of continuing to allow streateries.

Council asked questions of business owners and staff. Council consensus was to extend allowance of current streateries past December 31, 2021 for further discussion, and create an ad-hoc committee, consisting of the City Manager, Public Works & Utilities Director or other staff, businesses currently operating streateries, two councilmembers, an EDA representative and a downtown business owner that does not have a streatory.
