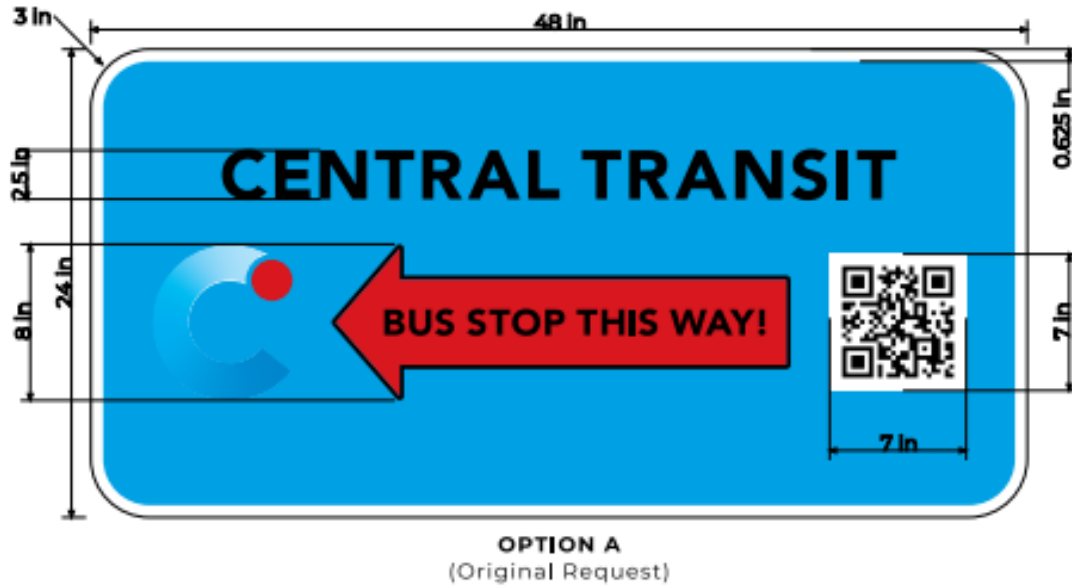

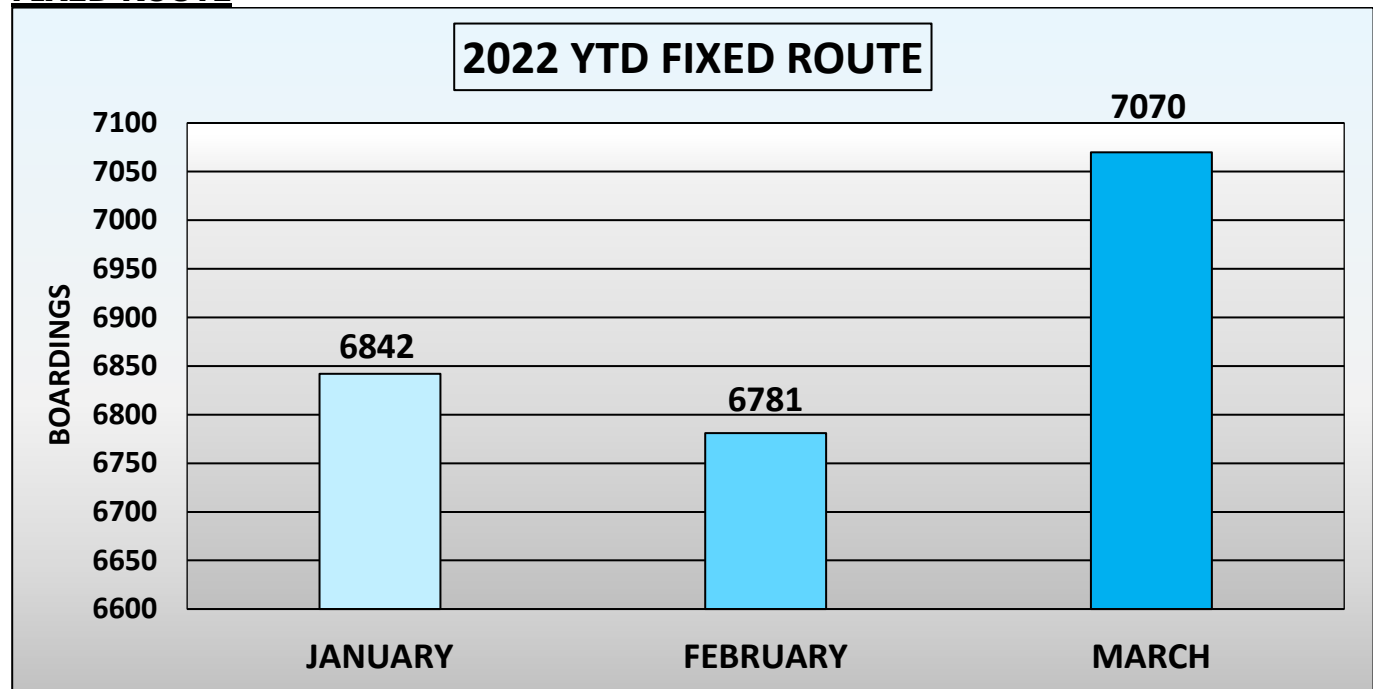

FIXED ROUTE

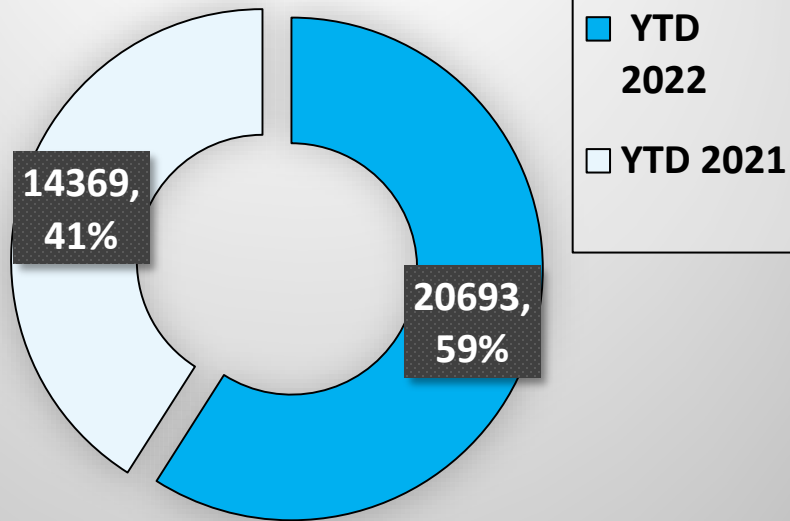

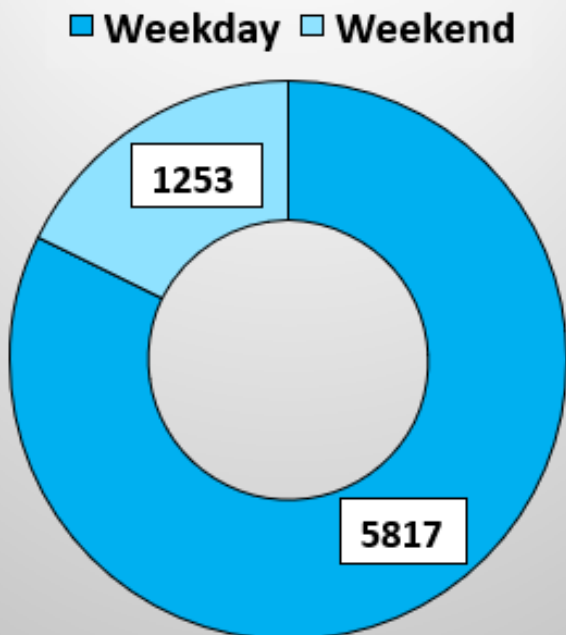

2021 to 2022 +44%

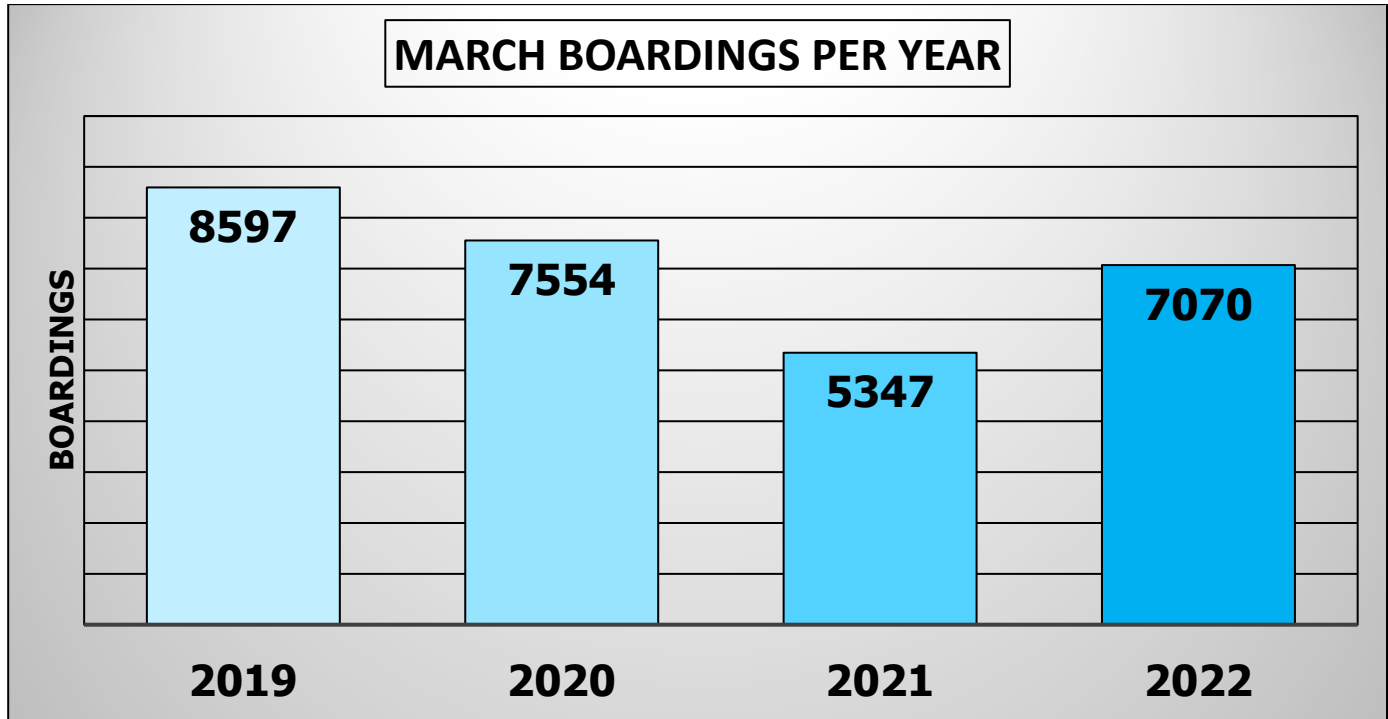
MARCH WEEKEND VS WEEKDAY

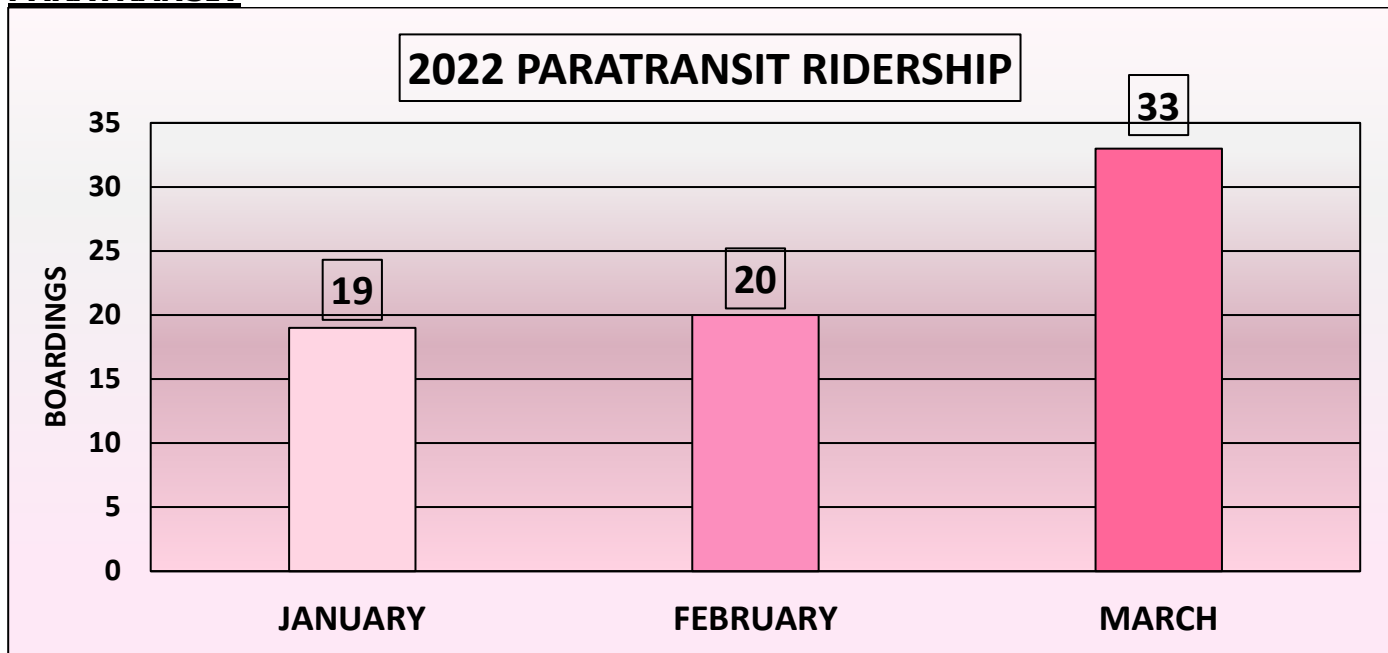

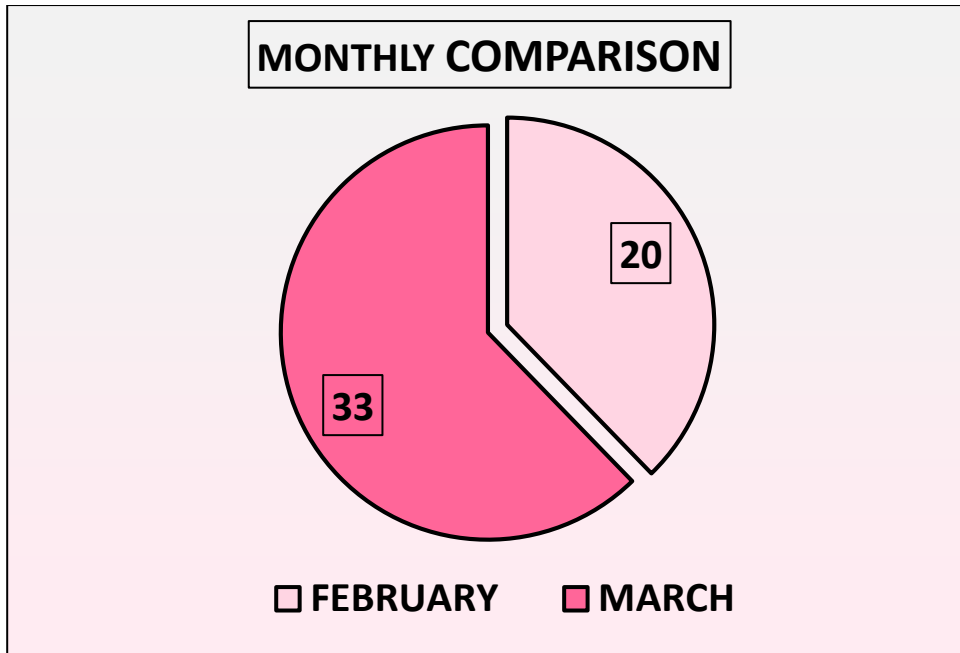

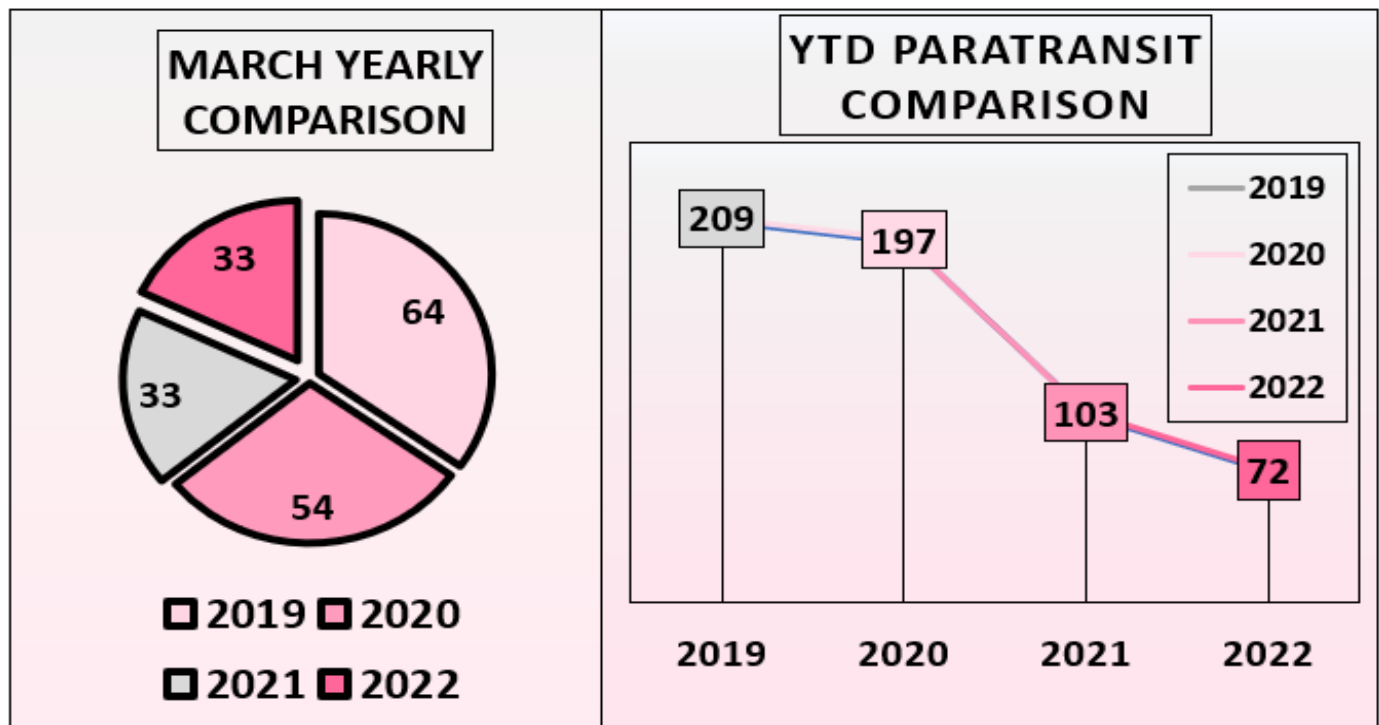
January to February +5% | February to March +65%

February to March 65%

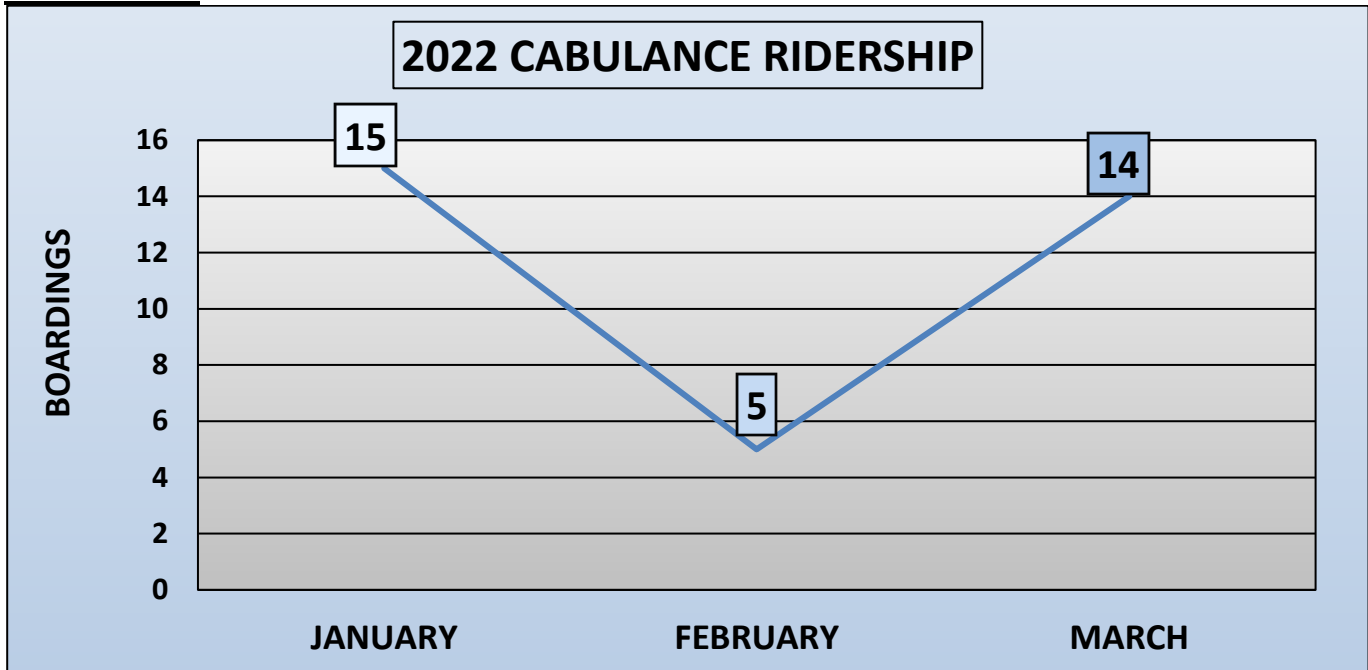

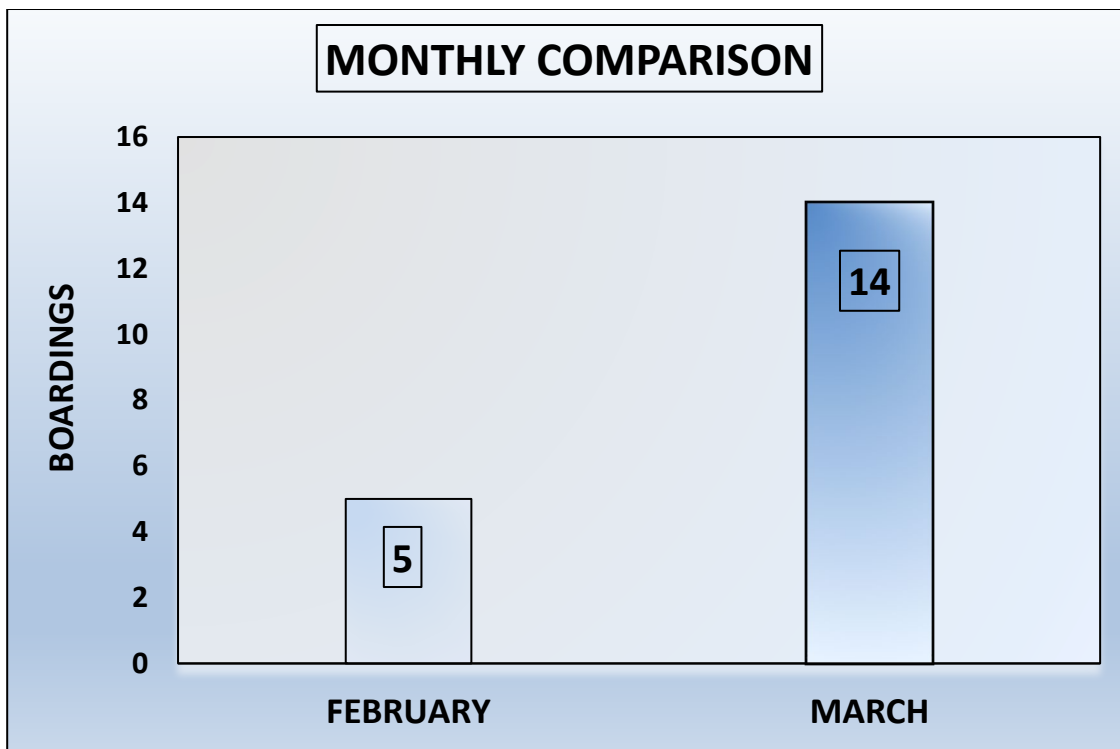

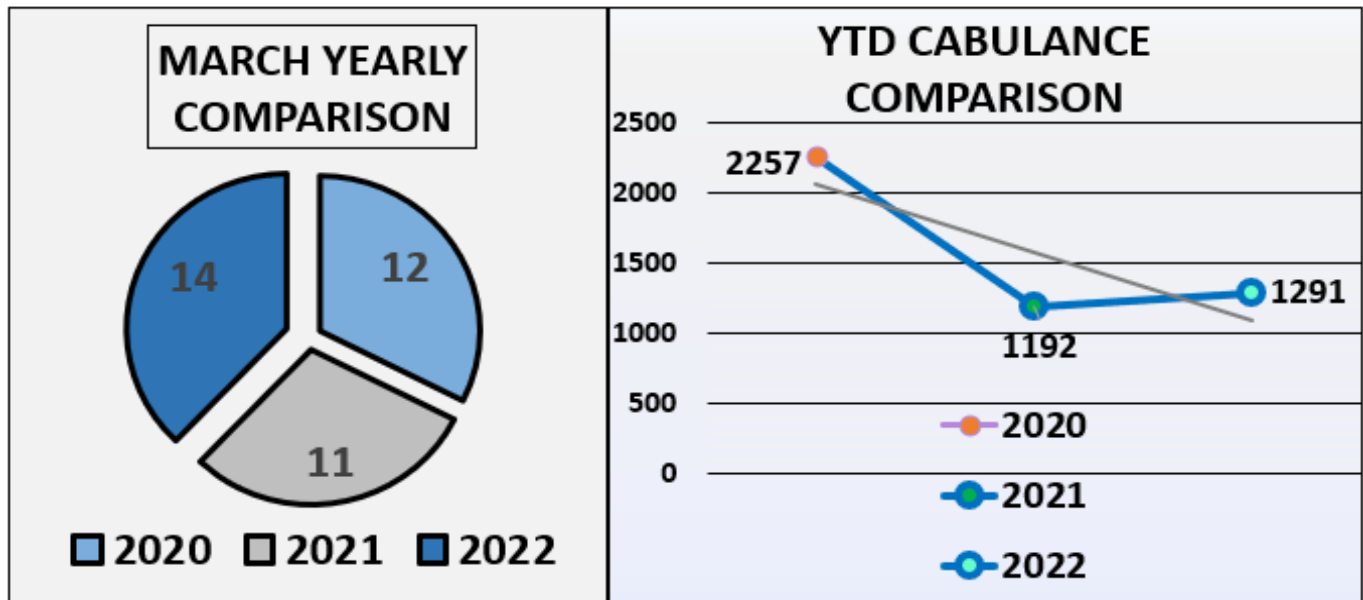

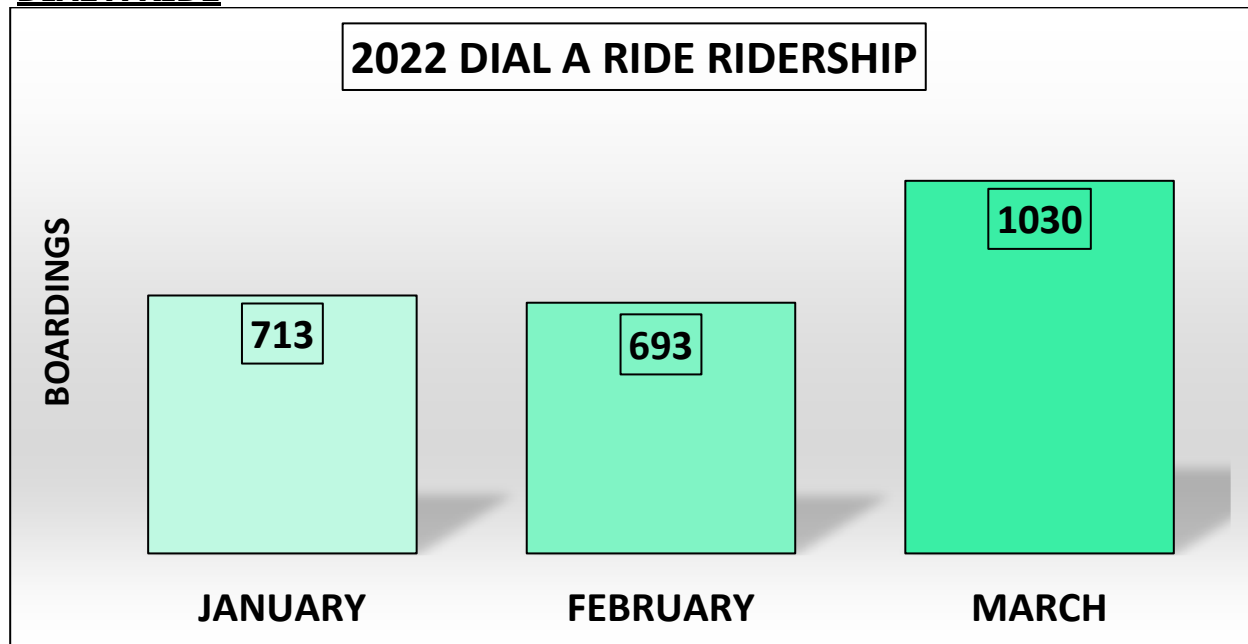

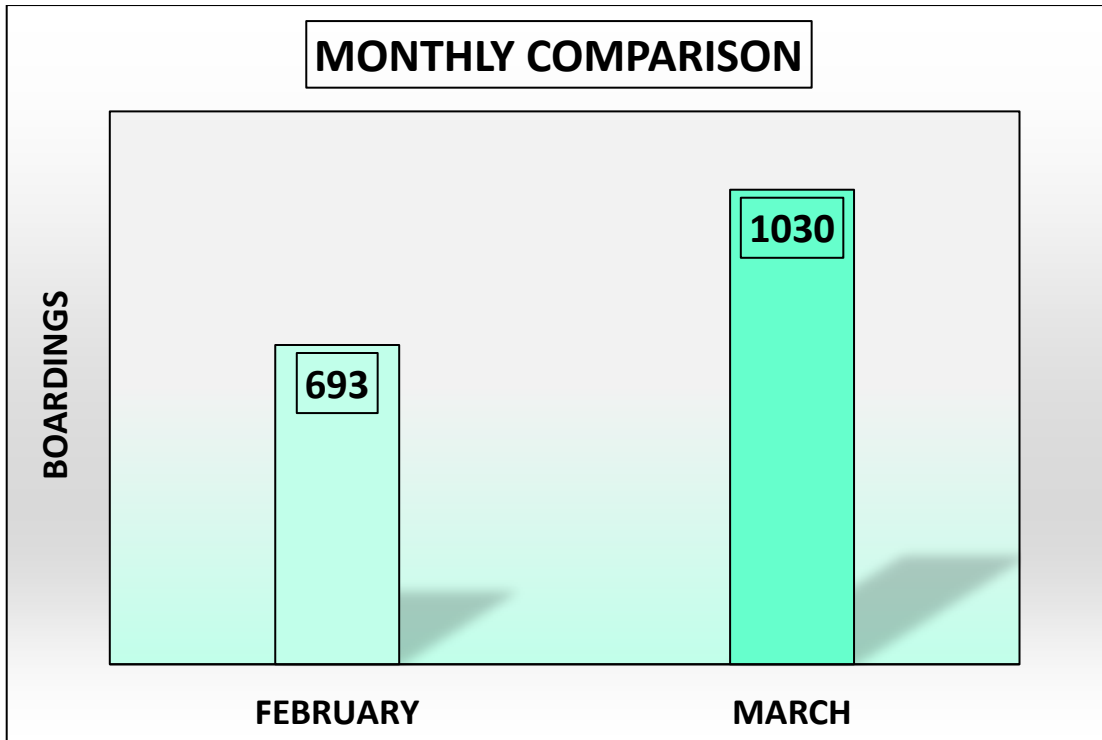

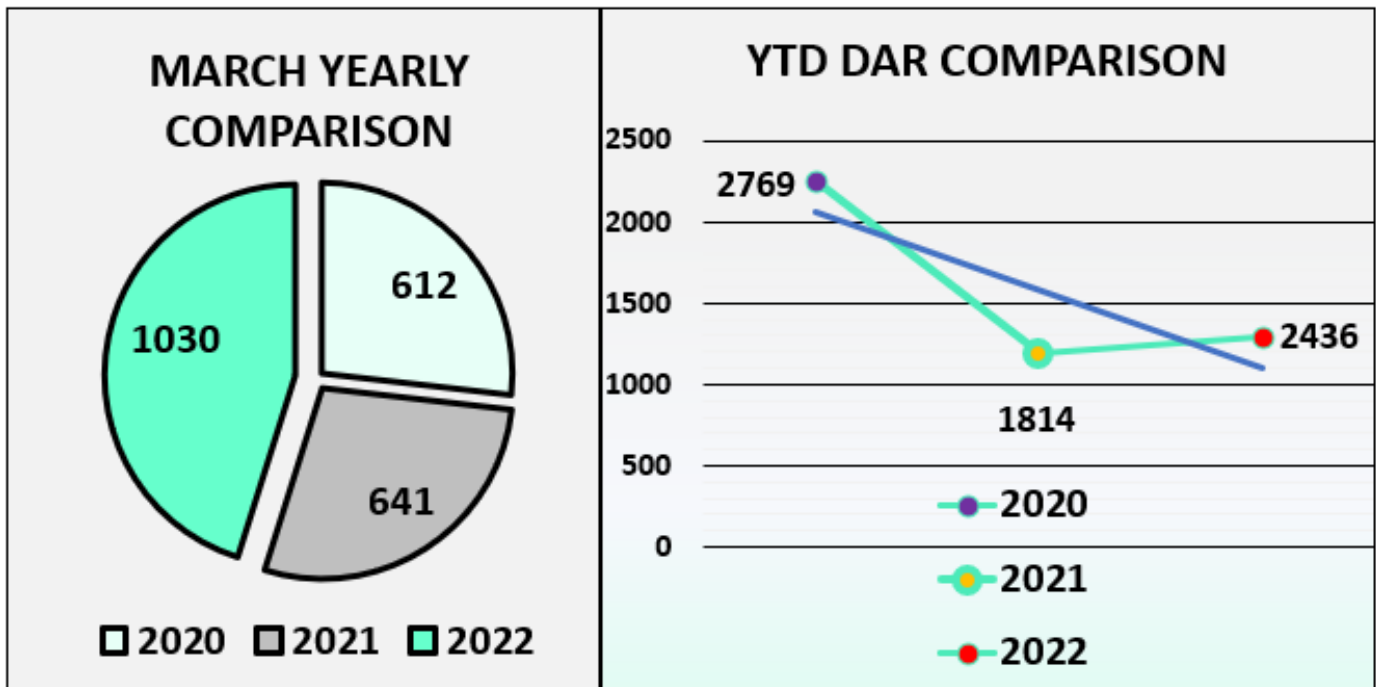

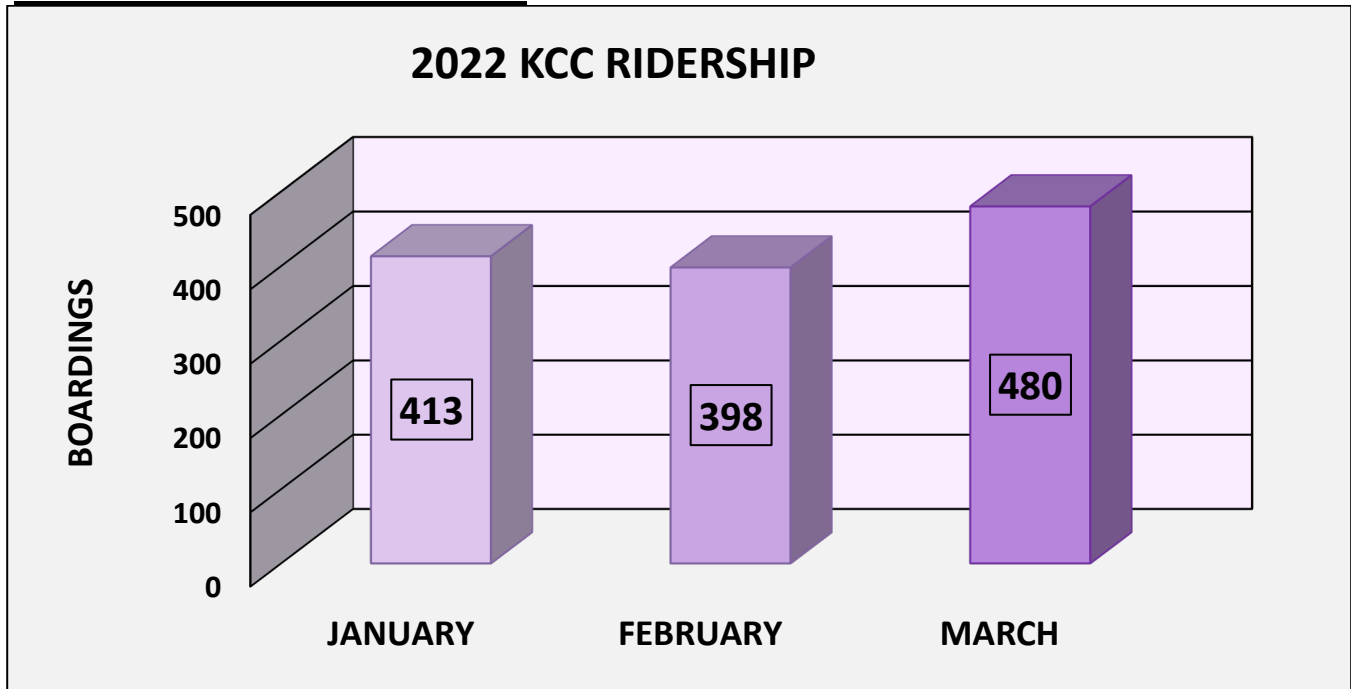

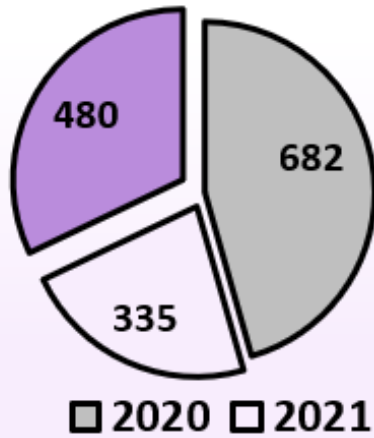

- County wide services within a 10 minute radius.
- Timeframe – 15 minutes from time of call for the vehicle to be enroute, then the drive time to the location.
- Estimated ride requests annually – 20
- Billing would be to 2 entities – KCHD 1 – KVH for all transports inside KCHD 1 boundaries. KCHD 2 (Upper County Hospital District) for all transports in KCHD 2 boundries.
